## Evidence of Russia-Linked Influence Operations in Africa | Stanford Internet Observatory

> Russia's global strategy for <u>reasserting itself</u> as a geopolitical superpower has led to an increased presence in Africa, where it has broadened efforts to shape the continent's politics and pursue new economic opportunities <u>to allay the effects of</u> <u>sanctions</u>. While the presence of Russian military instructors and <u>paramilitary</u> <u>groups</u> in Libya and the Central African Republic is well documented, there is emerging evidence that Russian-linked companies are now active in the information space as well. Yevgeny Prigozhin, the oligarch perhaps best known for <u>running the Internet Research Agency</u>, is central to this expansion.
