Health Workers Using TikTok to Fight COVID-19 Disinformation | Time

On one side of the split screen "duet," a video game car bounces down a mountain; on the other, the TikTok user "dr.noc" scrambles to talk as much as he can before the car slams into the ground. Noc, who in real life is Morgan McSweeney, a PhD scientist who researches treatments for diseases like COVID-19, is trying to debunk as many myths about coronavirus vaccines as he can before the final animated explosion.
