How Australia's fickleness on COVID vaccines is perpetuating global vaccine inequity | The Conversation

Despite assurances from Prime Minister Scott Morrison that Australia was at "the front of the queue" for COVID-19 vaccines, Australia's rate of vaccination ranks last in the OECD.

Nevertheless, Australia is still ahead of <u>scores of other nations</u> when it comes to vaccination rates, with many countries in the developing world unlikely to be able to vaccinate significant numbers of their people <u>before 2023</u>.

Global vaccine inequity is a "catastrophic moral failure", according to the directorgeneral of the World Health Organization, Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus.
