If You're Talking About 'Coronavirus' on Twitter, You're Probably a Bot | VICE

Nearly half the "people" talking about the coronavirus pandemic on Twitter are not actually people, but bots, according to new research from Carnegie Mellon University.

And many of those bots are rapidly feeding Twitter with harmful, false story lines about the pandemic, including some inspiring real-world activity, such as the theory that <u>5G towers cause COVID-19</u>, or state-sponsored propaganda from Russia and China that falsely claims the U.S. developed the coronavirus as a bioweapon or that American politicians are issuing "mandatory" lockdowns.
