In the Race to Crack Covid-19, Scientists Bypass Peer Review | Undark

As the SARS-COV-2 virus spreads, causing more than 800,000 confirmed <u>cases</u> of Covid-19 globally, researchers are scrambling to learn more about the virus. Their collective efforts have generated more than 1,900 papers, as doctors and scientists try to rapidly share new findings with each other and with the public.

At stake are urgent unanswered questions about Covid-19: Can a recovered patient get the disease again? What techniques will provide faster and more accurate tests? How effective is social distancing at slowing the spread of the disease?
