India considering appeals panel with power to reverse Facebook, Twitter and YouTube content moderation decisions | TechCrunch

India is proposing to create an appeals panel with the veto power to reverse content moderation decisions of social media firms, it said Monday evening, <u>republishing the draft changes</u> to the IT rules after quietly withdrawing it last week.

If enacted, it would be the first time globally that a nation creates an appeals panel of this kind. New Delhi, which is currently seeking public comments on the proposal with a 30-day deadline, said the new amendment "will not impact early stage or growth stage Indian companies or startups," in a relief for local giants such as Dailyhunt, ShareChat and Koo.
