## Limiting message forwarding on WhatsApp helped slow disinformation | MIT Technology Review

In January, WhatsApp <u>limited how often messages can be forwarded</u>—to only five groups instead of 20—in an attempt to slow the spread of disinformation. (They had previously limited it to 20 from 256.) <u>New research</u> suggests that the change is working, but more can still be done.

**The background:** When it comes to disinformation, Facebook and Twitter receive most of the attention. But WhatsApp has influenced <u>elections in Brazil</u> and <u>India</u>, and a <u>recent report</u> from NYU highlighted it as one of the platforms we should be worrying about more.
