## Mark Zuckerberg Says Facebook Won't Delay Livestreams After New Zealand Massacre | CNN

In an interview airing on "Good Morning America" on Thursday, the Facebook CEO said a delay "might" have limited the number of views of a <u>livestreamed video last</u> <u>month</u> purportedly showing a gunman walking into a mosque in New Zealand and opening fire.

"But it would also fundamentally break what livestreaming is for people. Most people are livestreaming, you know, a birthday party or hanging out with friends when they can't be together," Zuckerberg <u>told</u> George Stephanopoulos.

He said lives treaming is more than broadcasting — it's "communicating," because people comment in real time.

"So if you had a delay that would break that," Zuckerberg said.
