Nearly three-in-ten Americans believe COVID-19 was made in a lab | Pew Research Center

> As news and misinformation about the <u>COVID-19 pandemic</u> has spread, many Americans have encountered <u>conflicting narratives</u> about how the new coronavirus originated. Scientists have determined the virus <u>came about naturally</u>, but <u>there is</u> <u>some uncertainty</u> about how it first infected people.

> While a plurality of Americans (43%) say the new coronavirus most likely came about naturally, nearly three-in-ten (29%) say it most likely was created in a lab, according to a Pew Research Center survey conducted from March 10 to 16, 2020, as part of the Center's nearly yearlong <u>Election News Pathways project</u>.
