Older users share more misinformation. Your guess why might be wrong. | MIT Technology Review

The news: Misinformation on social media is often fueled by older adults, who share fake news and dubious links <u>more than other age groups</u>—up to seven times more than their younger counterparts. But a <u>new analysis</u> suggests people often make incorrect assumptions about why this might be, which leads some attempts at halting the spread of misinformation to failure.
