

# Twitter Expands QAnon Restrictions To Include Candidates, Elected Officials | Forbes

Twitter said Thursday it will extend its restrictions on QAnon-linked accounts and content to political candidates and elected officials who promote the conspiracy theory, a pivot in the company's stance from August when it [told Forbes](#) it was "evaluating" an "expansion" of the new policy.

Key Facts: In July, Twitter [cracked down](#) on the conspiracy theory, banning more than 7,000 accounts and preventing QAnon content from appearing on sections of its site — but its enforcement policy was murky when it came to elected officials and candidates.
