Twitter and Facebook revealed on Monday that they have discovered accounts believed to be linked to a Chinese disinformation campaign targeted at the Hong Kong protests. Twitter said it had found and suspended 936 accounts originating within China that were “deliberately and specifically attempting to sow political discord in Hong Kong” as part of a state-backed operation.
